An Image of the Evening Star in Darkness

Latin has a diverse group of feminine nouns with nominative singular *-gō*, genitive *-ginis*, such as *imāgō* 'image', *vesperūgō* 'evening star', and *cālīgō* 'darkness', that have been the subject of historical linguistic inquiry, on and off, for over a century. This paper offers a new exploration of these nouns and related issues.
